Plea Agreement

THIS DAY CAME the parties in interest and represented to the Court that they have entered into the following Plea Agreement:


- 1) The Defendant stands charged in this Court with grand larceny, a violation of Virginia Code Section 18.2 – 95 and possession of burglary tools, a violation of Virginia Code Section 18.2 – 94.
- 2) The Commonwealth will move to reduce the grand larceny to destruction of property, a violation of Virginia Code Section 18.2 – 137, **VCC Code VAN-2922-M1** and *nolle prosequi* the possession of burglary tools.
- 3) Defendant will plead guilty to the amended warrant.
- 4) The threshold for felony larceny prosecutions will increase to \$1,000 on July 1, 2020.
- 5) The value of the stolen item in this case is less than \$1,000 and Mr. Allan has facilitated the return of the item and it is now in the possession of law enforcement.
- 6) Mr. Allan has no criminal record.
- 7) The victim in this case is the City of Charlottesville. City Manager Dr. Tarron Richardson has been consulted and has provided input on case resolution and disposition.
- 8) Because of the information set forth in paragraphs 4-7 and because Mr. Allan has accepted responsibility and been cooperative throughout, the parties agree that the Court shall sentence the defendant to 90 days in jail. That sentence shall be suspended upon the condition that Mr. Allan perform 25 hours of community service


and be of good behavior for 12 months.

This Plea Agreement is the total agreement between the parties. There have been no other inducements, promises, threats or coercion of any kind imposed upon the Defendant by the Attorney for the Commonwealth or any agent or law enforcement officer of the Commonwealth. In the event that the Court declines to accept this agreement and implement its terms, both the defendant and Commonwealth hereby acknowledge that the defendant shall be free to withdraw his plea and a preliminary hearing shall be scheduled on the currently pending charges.
